Tuition Fees

Tuition is the annual fee to attend True North and covers all PACEs and academic requirements. Students may have to stay at home until payment is received. Tuition is due at the beginning of each month and can be paid by e-transfer to office@dfgc.ca or by ten postdated cheques, dated for the beginning of each month. Alternatively, if families choose to pay for the full year's tuition in one lump sum before or during the first month of school, a 5% discount is applied. (An additional surcharge of \$20.00 will be charged to Parents/Guardians for any NSF cheques.)



Application & Diagnostic Testing

For each new student, an initial non-refundable fee of \$50.00 will be paid by Parents/Guardians at the completion of the admittance procedure.

Each student wanting to attend True North will be required to take a Diagnostic Test. This test helps to determine any gaps in a student's academic progress and allows the Principal to make well-informed curriculum planning decisions so that students are not pushed ahead without learning all the skills and concepts of a particular grade level.

Standardized Testing

Students may be tested while attending True North. Parents/Guardians are expected to pay the cost of these tests, which could vary from grade to grade, and will be informed of any testing or fees well in advance.

Physical Education and Field Trip

Parents/Guardians are expected to pay some of the cost for Physical Education. We participate in activities (e.g. swimming, skating), which require additional fees for each student. During the year, we have field trips. Some of these costs are usually covered by fundraising.

Failed PACE Test

If a student fails a PACE test, there is a \$10.00 charge to purchase a repeat PACE.
